The photographs are arranged alphabetically by post office name.

SCOPE & CONTENT NOTE

This collection includes photographs of the exteriors and interiors of post offices, postmasters, and post office employees. Some exterior shots include street scenes and businesses with signs. Some postmaster and employee photos show people at the post office, while others are portraits. Older photographs generally originated at the Arizona Historical Society, while mid-twentieth century later generally came from Charles Maguire or the PHF Post Office Field Trip. Both territorial and statehood post offices are included from the entire state. If there is no folder for a known post office, that is because there is no known photograph in the Slusser's holdings of that post office.

Several well-known historic Arizona figures are represented in this collection and can be searched by name in the online catalog. This collection is cataloged at the folder (post office name) level; descriptions in the bibliographic record include specific names and places.
