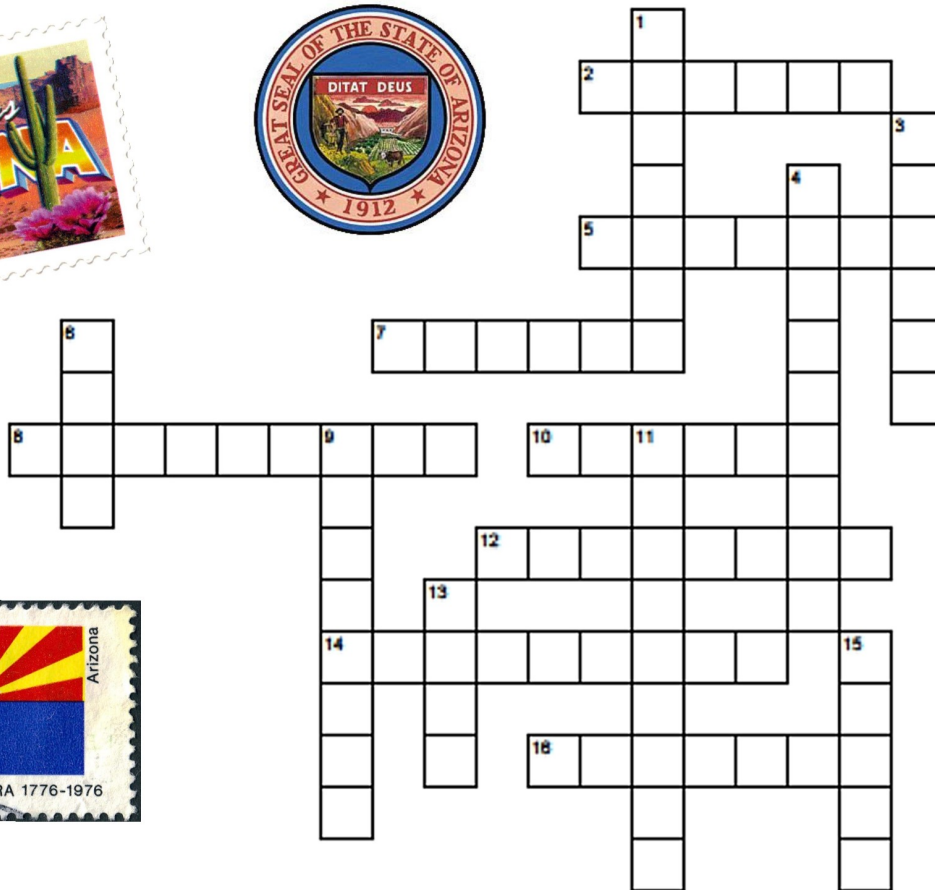




# Arizona Symbols
