State Size: 113,909 square miles



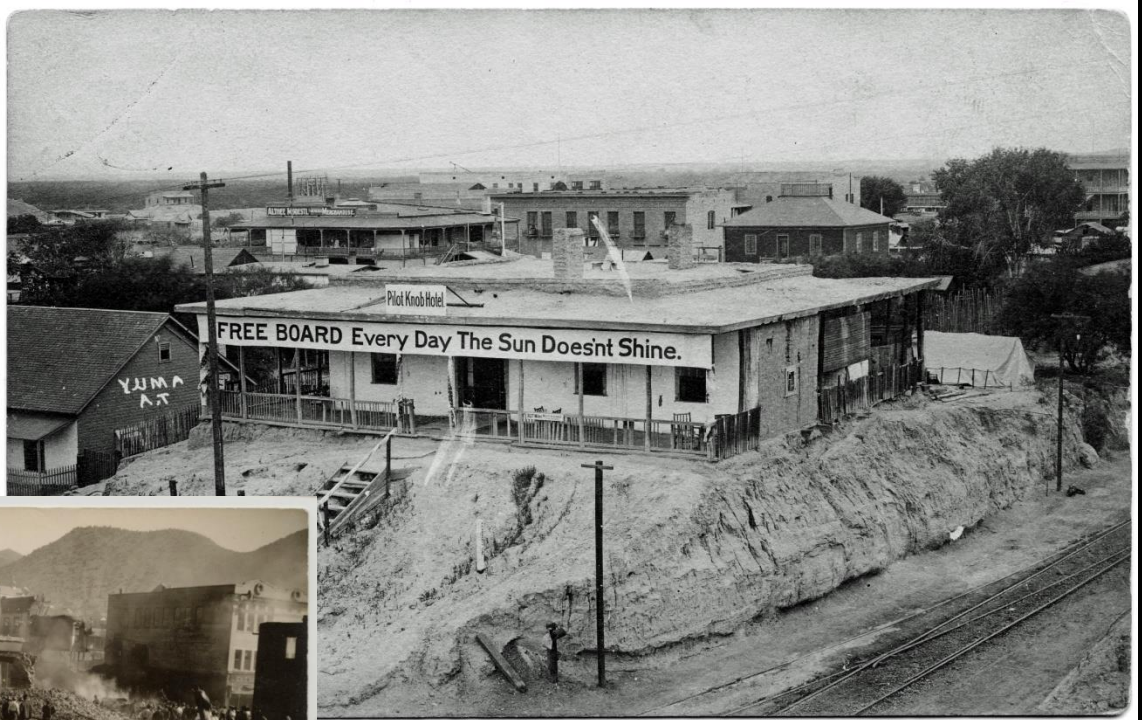
State Flag: Adopted in 1917. The 13 rays of red and gold on the top half of the flag represent both the 13 original colonies of the Union, and the rays of the Western setting sun. The red and the blue are the same shades as the flag of the USA. The flag was designed by Charles W. Harris and first seen by Ian D. Hayden. Blue and yellow are the Arizona colors, and red and yellow the colors of the Spanish Conquistadores headed by Coronado who first came to Arizona in 1540. The copper star represents Arizona as the largest producer of copper in the nation.

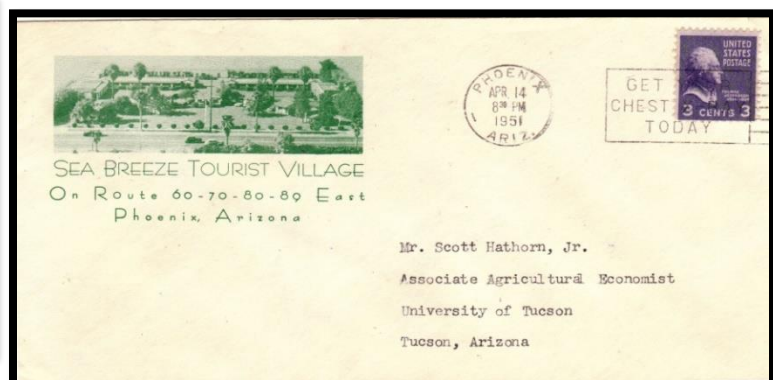
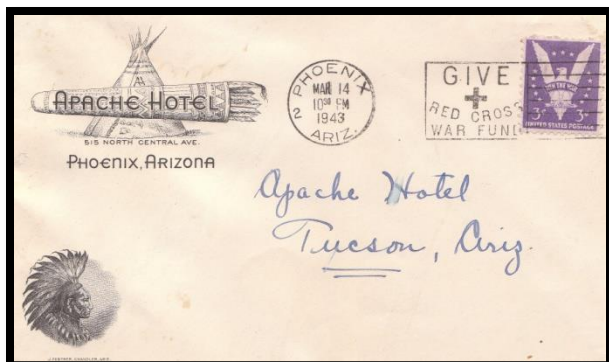

I have not written to you for a
 number of days - have been very busy receiving

 my left leg have got well but my left groin has not

 broke & ran considerably, I have used
 "444" horse medicine, & I think I am
 right in a week. On the 6th day of Nov^r
 this place commined an attachment
 Chas H Beach Editor of the Arizona Miner
 and attached 14 Bundles Printing Paper in
 I wrote Beach that I would attend to it
 he wrote me to go ahead, & I went ahead
 think I have got them better, yesterday
 I rec^d the enclosed paper & the trial com
 at 2 PM to day. There is nothing to write, only
 that by attending to Beach's suit it will give
 me a little notoriety &c.

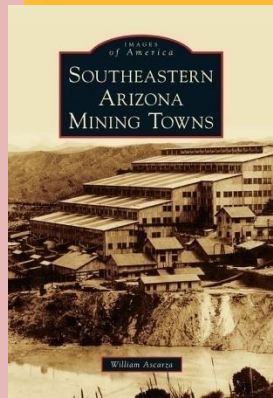
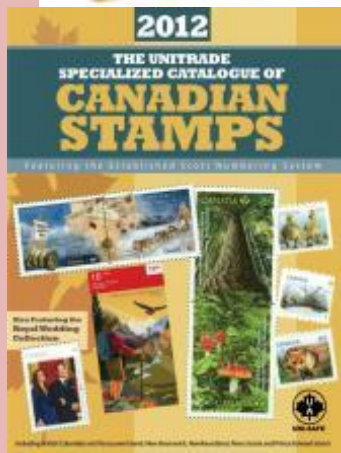
