- Kids may **write letters** requesting stamps. Teachers may send an envelope full of letters. Approximately 30 stamps will be sent back to the student. Please have the student list five topics in their letter from the topical list on our website. Don't forget the return address!!

Please read the following information:

- 1.) All stamps and lessons are for educational use only. The lessons are the property of the PHF and cannot be changed or sold by anyone. The stamps may not be sold. They are for educational use only.
- 2.) A master copy of the lesson is provided so that you can make copies for your students or children. Lesson stamp packets are sent for every student in your classroom. PowerPoints files will be sent to you in your order confirmation email. Power points also have stamp packets.
- 3.) Stamp availability fluctuates throughout the year and determines the number of stamps we provide per order.
- 4.) A three week turnaround can be common, so plan accordingly.
- 5.) Teachers and families may order four lessons and four topicals per month.
- 6.) Domestic orders via our store are sent free of charge. International and/or extremely heavy orders may be subject to a shipping charge.
